Dear Colleagues,

the 22nd Congress of the Euroacademia Multidisciplinaria Neurotraumatologica (EMN) will be hosted in Pavia, Italy, in 25-27th May 2017. The aim is to develop scientific sharing on recent methods, assessments and techniques for the treatment of patients with brain and spinal cord injuries, from the acute and neurosurgical setting to the rehabilitation and social -work activation.

Specialists of different disciplines will participate to garantee the highest level of a multidisciplinary approach.

Main topics are the updating of surgical, pharmachological, rehabilitative and clinical methods.

In particular, the congress will develop discussion on epidemiology, and state of the art of therapeutic strategies (emerging risk factors; clinical strategies in ICU and neurosurgery setting; assessment and monitoring of injuries in acute phase); on the physiopathological basis of recovery mechanisms and neuroplasticity (advanced approaches such as neuromodulation techniques, robotics for surgery and rehabilitation; telemonitoring or the telerehabilitation, neurorehabilitation outcomes, patient management and caregiver education and support).

We planned for this Congress edition, the 22nd, a joint session with the World Neurorehabilitation Federation (WFNR) to enhance the scientific sharing on rehabilitation.

The congress is going to take place in Pavia, at the Congress Center of the Salvatore Maugeri Foundation, conveniently equipped for all the scientific activities. An inviting social program is planned in the city of Pavia and surroundings to empower professional sharing and social meetings.

Il 22mo Congresso dell' Accademia Europea Neurotraumatologica (EMN) si terrà a Pavia, dal 25 al 27 Maggio 2017.

L'obiettivo del Congresso sarà quello di sviluppare e aggiornare a livello internazionale le conoscenze riguardo la presa in cura dei pazienti con cerebrolesione e mielolesione dalla fase acuta, rianimatoria e neurochirurgica, alla fase riabilitativa e al reinserimento sociale e professionale. I relatori invitati, afferenti alle diverse discipline, garantiranno la qualità del dialogo e delle conoscenze.

Gli argomenti del Congresso saranno suddivisi in diverse aree tematiche: l'epidemiologa e lo stato dell'arte delle strategie terapeutiche nelle lesioni traumatiche del Sistema Nervoso, con riferimento ai setting di terapia intensiva e neurochirurgia, i fattori di rischio, il monitoraggio clinico ed operatorio e le strategie terapeutiche della fase acuta, le basi neurofisiologiche dei meccanismi di recupero e della neuro plasticità. Verranno approfondite le nuove tecniche di riabilitazione quali la stimolazione cerebrale profonda, la stimolazione cerebrale non invasiva, i trattamenti robotici, le metodiche di teleriabilitazione, le misurazioni di outcome funzionale e l'importanza della informazione / educazione dei pazienti e del Caregiver

.Per l'edizione di questo Congresso annuale è prevista una sessione scientifica speciale in collaborazione con Colleghi e Specialisti appartenenti alla Federazione Mondiale di Neuroriabilitazione (WFNR) con lo scopo di approfondire gli aspetti riabilitativi durante tutte le fasi del trattamento del paziente con cerebro lesione e mielolesione traumatica.
